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SCOPE

The scope of this Plan is to provide:

- a. Information and guidance, based on recommendations developed by the World Health Organization (WHO), on the precautions to be taken to minimize risks to seafarers, passengers and others on board Company's ships from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).**
- b. Instructions and actions in case of emergency.**

Definitions

COVID-19: The novel coronavirus, that has not been previously identified in humans.

COVID-19 Incident: Every case where symptoms of COVID-19 may be suspected or every case where COVID-19 has been diagnosed.

Medical Isolation Area: Isolation Area is an area designated for crewmembers or passengers who present COVID-19 symptoms. Specifications of the Isolation Area on board can be found in paragraph 3.4

Contaminated Area: Any area on board the vessel including surfaces / items that have been in direct contact with the persons presenting COVID-19 symptoms. Special instructions for disinfection of contaminated areas and treatment of equipment on board are presented in paragraph 2.6

PCR: Polymerase Chain Reaction is a method widely used in molecular biology to rapidly make millions to billions of copies of a specific DNA sample allowing scientists to take a very small sample of DNA and amplify it to a large enough amount to study in detail.

Spillover: A jump of a virus from animals to humans
